2. 1st - 6th August 2023 will be "World Youth Day". The Parish and Youth Groups are requested to prepare for this earnestly. Parish preparations include financials and selecting delegates; **only 5 delegates per Deanery**. The Parish and Youth Groups are urged to embark on fundraising ASAP to raise sufficient funds for the costs.
