 - e) To constitute the **PPC** we need only **11 elected members**. However, nominations can be up to any number.
- **6.** Parishioners are informed that Communion can be brought to the residences of those who want to receive Communion but cannot come to church. If you are in this category, or you know such a person, please inform the Priest or Parish Office.
