- **2.** Cleaning of the Church on 26th August 2023 will be the turn of A Voz Divina Choir and the Charismatic Group, starting at 09h00.
- 3. From 3rd 8th September 2023, Fr. Johannes will be away on his Annual Retreat at Dobra; and from 10th 17th September 2023, he will be out of office attending the International Eucharistic Congress Preparatory Assembly.
- **4.** Third Marriage Bann: Vernon Mwazi & Veneranda N. Likela . They intend to get married on 25th August 2023 at Omagongati Roman Catholic Church.
- Parishioners are informed that registration for Sacraments' catechetical instructions at the Cathedral Parish and at St. Paul's College will be from 1st September to 31st October 2023. The requirements are as follows:
 - a) A candidate must be 12 years old for First Holy Communion and 14 years for Confirmation.
 - b) Copy of updated Baptism Card.
 - c) Copy of Birth Certificate.
 - d) Copy of Godparent's Baptism Card.
 - e) Copy of 1% Blue Card (for both parents and godparents).
 - f) A **Testimonial letter** from their Parish Priest if parents or Godparents are not registered members of St. Mary's Cathedral Parish.
- **6.** Parishioners are reminded that the term of office for the current PPC is ending at the end of this year. Parishioners should, therefore, start identifying their candidates of choice for nomination in October and eventually election in November 2023. When identifying a candidate, please, consider the following:
 - a) The candidate must be living in communion with the church
 - b) The candidate should be **18 years** of age and above
 - c) Should be a registered member of the St Mary's Cathedral Parish
 - d) Take into account the candidate's profession, apostolate or ministry
 - e) Nominated candidates can be up to any number but to constitute a PPC we need only 11 elected members.
- 7. Parishioners who intend to get married are required to declare their intention and register at the Parish office <u>6 months</u> prior to their proposed Marriage Date.
- 8. On Sunday 3rd September 2023 there will be children's Mass at the 10:40 slot. The Mass will be led by the children themselves. Teachers are requested to do the necessary to prepare the children to lead the Mass and parents are urged to bring all children aged below 15 years to that Mass.
- 9. The Missionary Sisters of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus are reminding everyone about the **Annual Pilgrimage at Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Shrine at Otjiwarongo** on 1st-2nd September 2023. For details, please see the notice board.
