- Cleaning of the church this Saturday 16thSeptember will be the turn of the MAMIS, OMINIONS and First Year Confirmation candidates, starting at 09h00.
- 2. On 24th September 2023 there will be Baptism & Reception into Full Communion with the Roman Catholic Church of children of catechetical age at the 10h40 Mass.
- 3. On Saturday 30th September 2023, there will be First Holy Communion of St. Paul's College candidates at 09h00 here at the Cathedral Parish.
- **4.** On **30th September 2023** Sr. Hildegard Kindergarten will hold a bazaar. The Kindergarten is a project of our Parish. Let's come in force with children to support it. Needless to say, its success will rely on the usual participation of our Men's Group, especially in the braai department. We thank them in advance for their usual unfailing involvement.
- 5. On **8th October** there will be an **Elders' Mass** at **10h40** to be followed with some refreshments. All **aged 60+** are encouraged to attend the Mass and socialize thereafter.
- 6. The Catholic Men's Association of Namibia will hold its National Assembly from 15th to 17th September 2023 at Katima Mulilo. Delegates from our Men's Group will represent our Parish and they will cover, among others, their own travel, accommodation, as well as registration costs. - 7. Registration for Sacraments' catechetical instructions (at the **Cathedral Parish** and at **St. Paul's College**) will be from **1**st **September 31st October 2023.** Requirements:
 - a) A candidate <u>must</u> be 12 years for 1st Holy Communion and 14 years for Confirmation
 - b) A copy of Updated Baptism Card
 - c) A copy of **Birth Certificate**
 - d) A copy of Godparent's Baptism Card
 - e) A copy of 1% Blue Card for both parents and Godparents
 - f) A **Testimonial letter** from their Parish Priest if parents or Godparents are not registered at St. Mary's Cathedral Parish.
- **8.** Parishioners are reminded that the term of office for the current PPC is ending at the end of this year. Therefore, Parishioners should start identifying candidates for nomination in October and election in November 2023.
- **9.** Parishioners who intend to get married are required to declare their intention and register their intended marriage **6 months** prior to their proposed marriage date.
- **10.** Although all restrictions relating to **COVID-19 pandemic** have been lifted, it is still up to each one of us to ensure that we remain healthy.
