- Youths from various parishes in the Windhoek Deanery are organizing a reflection on the Marian dogmas during the month of October 2023. The reflections will be held on the 4 Saturdays of the month starting at 15h00. The venue will be announced later. - 3. From 1st to 31st October 2023, Fr Johannes will be on Leave. Hence, he will not be in office
- Parishioners, please be informed that Celebration Hymnal books are now available in the Bookshop at N\$ 350 each.
- Registration for Sacraments' catechetical instructions (at the Cathedral Parish and at St. Paul's College) started on 1st September and will end on 31st October 2023. The requirements are:
 - a) A candidate <u>must</u> be 12 years for 1st Holy Communion and 14 years for Confirmation
 - b) A copy of **Updated Baptism Card**
 - c) A copy of Birth Certificate
 - d) A copy of Godparent's Baptism Card
 - e) A copy of **1% Blue Card** for both parents and Godparents
 - f) A **Testimonial letter** from their Parish Priest if parents or Godparents are not registered members of St. Mary's Cathedral Parish.

- 7. On Sunday 8th October there will be an Elders' Mass at 10h40 to be followed with refreshments. All parishioners aged 60 and above are cordially invited to attend the Mass and socialize thereafter.
- **8.** Parishioners are reminded that the term of office of the current PPC is ending at the end of this year. Therefore, Parishioners should start identifying candidates for nomination in October and election in November 2023. When identifying a candidate, please, consider the following requirements:
 - a) The candidate must be living In Communion with the Church.
 - b) The candidate should be at least 18 years old.
 - c) The candidate should be a registered member of the Cathedral Parish.
 - d) Consider also the candidate's profession, apostolate or ministry.

 Nominated candidates can be up to any number but to constitute a PPC we need only 11 elected members.
- Parishioners who intend to get married are required to declare their intention and register their intended marriage <u>6 months</u> prior to their proposed marriage date.
