- Registration for 2024 Sacraments' catechetical instructions at the Cathedral Parish and at St. Paul's College, started on 1<sup>st</sup> September and will end on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023. Please register on time as there will be no late registration.
- 5. The Month of the Rosary will close on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023. The Rosary will be prayed at the usual time of 17h30 and thereafter will follow the closing Holy Mass. All Parishioners are warmly invited to attend that closing. There won't be Mass in the morning.
- 6. November is a special month in the Catholic Liturgical Calendar to remember the faithful departed. Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> November is All Saints Day and Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> November is All Souls Day. On both days Holy Mass will be in the evening at 18h00. On Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> November there will be the usual prayers at the cemetery after the 07h30 Holy Mass.
- 7. On 5<sup>th</sup> November 2023 there will be Deanery's Youths' Holy Mass at 10h40. Youths in the Deanery celebrate such Mass once a year at one Parish in the Deanery. On the 5<sup>th</sup> of November will be the Cathedral Parish's turn to host that Mass. Therefore, our youths are highly encouraged to attend that Mass.
- 8. Parishioners are informed that Communion can be brought to those who want to receive Communion but cannot come to church. If you are in this category, or you know such a person, please inform the Parish Office.
