3. CWL Will be responsible to leading the Stations of the Cross on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024
4. Parishioners who intend to get married are encouraged to **acquaint** themselves with the **requirements list** posted on **Parish Notice Boards**; and are required to declare their intention at the Parish Office and register with the Priest **6 months** prior to their proposed Marriage Date.
