- 2. Sunday, 2nd June 2024, is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. There will be only one Mass to be said at St Boniface and will be preceded by a procession from the Cathedral to St Boniface. In the afternoon, there will be a special Adoration session at the Cathedral, starting at 16h30, which will be followed by refreshments for parishioners to socialize. Please come in numbers to adore the Blessed Sacrament. Everyone, and youths in particular, are highly encouraged to partake in this special adoration.
- 3. The next Infant Baptism will be on 16th June 2024 at the 10h40 Mass. The Baptism will be preceded by classes on 10th 12th June at 18h00. All parents & Godparents have to attend those classes and they should register by 7th June 2024 and ensure <u>all</u> requirements as per requirements list issued by the Parish Office are provided.
- 4. Parishioners are invited to a Seminar on "History of the Roman Catholic Church: A Journey Through The Phases In The Life Of The Church" that is organized by the PPC to take place on 11th June 2024, at 18h00. <u>Youths</u>, in particular, are highly encouraged to attend.
