- 3. On 27th July 2024 there will be **training of Readers**, both old and new, starting at 09h00, at the Kindergarten. Please, please, DON'T MISS.
- 4. On 27th July the St. Boniface Parish will hold a fund-raising Sports Day and they have requested us to support them by attending and participating in the various sports codes. Our Men's Group are spearheading the Cathedral's participation. Please join them to form strong teams to beat St Boniface and more importantly to stimulate inter-parish collaboration.
- 5. Henceforth there will be ringing of Angelus bells at 06h00, 12h00 & 18h00 in keeping with Catholic traditions.
