2. The **Sunday School** will host a Back-to-School fun-day on **Saturday 20th July at 10h00-16h00**. Parents should register with the teachers, to be added in the WhatsApp Group.
3. **Baptism of young catechumens** and **Reception of young Converts** is scheduled for **11th August 2024** at the **10h40 Mass**. **Parents and guardians of these children are reminded to bring outstanding documents before the above date to avoid children being dropped.**
4. Parishioners are invited to a **Seminar** on: **"History of the Roman Catholic Church: A Journey Through the Phases in the Life of the Church"** organized by the PPC. The Seminar is scheduled for **23rd July 2024 at 18h00 in the Parish Hall**. **Youths** are particularly highly encouraged to attend.
