- 1. Cleaning of the Church on Saturday 10th August 2024 will be the turn of Altar Servers & the Charismatic Group starting at 09h00.
- On Sunday 11th August 2024 the 10h40 Mass will be Children's Mass. Children will lead
 the Mass, after which they will be treated to some refreshments. Parents are
 encouraged to bring to that Mass all children aged below 15 years.
- 3. Alongside the **Children's Mass** on 11th August 2024, there will also be **Baptism** of **young catechumens** and **Reception** of **young converts** during the 10h40 Mass. Parents should bring outstanding documents before then to avoid children being dropped out.
- Registration for Baptism for children of Catechetical Age, Reception of Children of Catechetical Age, 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation will be in September & October. Parents/guardians are urged to start getting the required documents ready.
- 5. The Administrator will <u>not be in Office</u> on Wednesday mornings and Fridays from **08h00 to 09h30** as he will be teaching at **St. Charles Lwanga Seminary**.
- 6. The PPC is organizing a St. Mary's Cathedral Clean-Up Campaign to take place on 17th August 2024 around the Church premises. Parishioners are encouraged to participate in numbers. Apart from physical participation, support to the event can be provided in the form of donations of refuse bags, water, soft drinks, brotchens, etc. for refreshments. In preparation for the event, a short talk on the theme of Desertification, Climate Change and Land Degradation will be given on the 3rd & 4th of August 2024 after every Mass.
- 7. The next Baptism of infants will be on 25th August 2024. Parents who intend to have their babies baptized on that day should register their babies before the deadline of 9th August 2024, making sure all the requirements as per requirements list are attached to the application form.
- 8. To encourage youth participation in activities at the Church, the St Mary's Cathedral Youth and Vocation PPC Committee is inviting all Cathedral youths to fill-in a form that has been posted on the notice board. Scan the QR code to access the form. If you experience problems in accessing the link, get in touch with the organisers at the contact details provided on the poster.
- 9. The next **Pre-marriage Workshop** is scheduled for the 09th 11th August 2024, at **Maria Regina Oblates Conference Centre, Dobra.** Interested Parishioners should register at the Parish Office as soon as possible. The Workshop is open to non Catholics as well.
- 10. Parishioners who intend to get married are encouraged to acquaint themselves with the Requirements List posted on Parish Notice Boards; and are required to declare their intention at the Parish office and register with the Priest <u>6 months</u> prior to their proposed Marriage Date.
- 11. Although all restrictions relating to COVID-19 pandemic have been lifted, it is still up to each one of us to ensure that we remain healthy.
