1. On Saturday 17th August 2024 there will be First Holy Communion Mass for Holy Cross Convent candidates at 09h00.
2. Cleaning of the Church on that day, **17th August**, will be the turn of **Ambassadors & NATEC**. Due to the Holy Mass that will be taking place in the morning, the cleaning will be at 15h00.
3. Registration for: **Baptism for children of Catechetical Age, Reception of Children of Catechetical Age, First Holy Communion and Confirmation**, will be in **September & October**. Parents & guardians are urged to start getting the required documents ready.
4. As we prepare to celebrate **Mission Sunday on 20th October 2024**, the Catechists will be working with **Sunday School teachers** in preparing children to lead the **10h40 Mass** on that day. Parishioners are encouraged to support them in any way possible.
5. The Administrator will **not be in Office** the whole morning on **Wednesdays**, and **from 08h00 to 09h30** on Fridays, as he will be teaching at **St. Charles Lwanga Seminary**.
6. The PPC is organizing a Cathedral Parish Clean-Up Campaign that will take place on 17th August 2024 around the Church premises. Parishioners are encouraged to participate in numbers. Apart from physical participation, support to the event can be provided in the form of donations of refuse bags, water, soft drinks, brotchens, etc. for refreshments. Kindly give such donations at the Parish Office.
7. The next **Baptism of infants** will be on **25th August 2024**.
8. **The Ambassadors of a Worldwide Brotherhood** are organising Holy Mass for **people with Disabilities** that will be held at **St Mary's Help of Christians Parish, Khomasdal on the 1st of September 2024 at 10h00**.
