 - b. **For First Holy Communion**: Copies of Parents' & Godparents' Church Dues contribution cards; Certified Copies of candidate's Baptism & Birth Certificates; Testimonial letter from one's Parish if not a registered member of St. Mary's Cathedral Parish.
 - c. **For Confirmation**: Copies of Parents' & Godparents' Church Dues contribution cards; Candidate's certified Birth, Baptism & First Holy Communion Certificates; Testimonial letter from one's Parish if not a registered member of St. Mary's Cathedral Parish.
 - d. For Converts: Certified copies of Candidate's Birth Certificate, Baptism Card, and Godparent's Church Dues Contribution card. If married to a Catholic: Certified copy of Marriage Certificate; Testimonial letter if not a registered member of St. Mary's Cathedral Parish.
