- 2. PPC regrets to announce that the 'Spring Ball' that was to take place on 7th Sept has been postponed to next year at a date to be announced later to allow adequate time for preparations. Groups that have sold tickets should deposit the money with the Parish Office and get a receipt. Individuals who received tickets to sell should inform Dr Kudumo (0811229015) or the Parish Office how many tickets they sold and how many are still with them.
- The deadline for All Lectors, old & new, to confirm that their names appear correctly on the Lectors' list posted on the Notice Board is today, 15th Sept. Any omission or correction should be reported to the Parish Office. Installation will be this coming Sunday, on 22nd Sept. 2024.
- 4. To celebrate **Mission Sunday on 20**th **October, Catechists & Sunday School Teachers** are preparing children to lead the **10h40 Mass** on that day. Parishioners are encouraged to support them in any way possible.
- 5. This year's Confirmation will be on 16th November 2024; and will be combined with the Silver Jubilee celebration of the Episcopal Consecration of the Archbishop. Parishioners are encouraged to participate actively in the preparations for those events.
