1. Cleaning of the Church on **Saturday 02<sup>nd</sup> November** will be the turn of **Second Year Communion** candidates & **Senior Youths**. Leaders of groups that are assigned cleaning duty should contact the Office on Thursday or Friday to arrange what time the cleaning should be done as there may be activities taking place in church on Saturday. Then they should pass the message to their members.
2. This coming weekend we have days of obligation as follows:  
**Friday 1<sup>st</sup> of November is All Saints Day.** Mass will be as usual at 18h00.  
**Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> November is All Souls Day.** Mass will be at 09h00. The Men's Group will lead the Requiem Mass; which will be followed by a visit to Gammam's (Pioneerspark) cemetery where the priest will lead prayers for the faithful departed; and bless flowers or articles that you wish to place at a grave of your loved one.  
Parishioners are urged to honour these Catholic traditions by turning up in numbers and bringing articles for placing on the graves of loved ones.
3. During the month of November, the Catholic church honours the faithful departed. A box will be placed at the foot of the Altar in which you can place names of your loved ones who have gone to their eternal rest. The Priest will be praying for them every day for the whole month.
4. **The Silver Jubilee celebrations of His Grace Archbishop Liborius Nashenda** is scheduled for **November 16, 2024**. It will coincide with this year's Confirmation. Parishioners are requested to donate in kind or cash to make the event memorable. Kindly contact the Parish Office for details.
