- 1. Cleaning of the Church on Saturday 8th February 2025 will be the turn of Communion Assistants & Second Year Confirmation Candidates.
- 2. All **Altar Servers**, and those interested in being trained as such, are requested to register at the Parish Office for their upcoming training that will be announced soon.
- 3. **Registration** is ongoing and will end on **15**th **March 2025** for adults aged 21 and above who need: **Baptism**; **1**st **Holy Communion**; **Confirmation**; **or are converting to Catholicism from other denominations.**
- 4. Sunday School Classes will resume on 9th February 2025. Registration is open for children aged 3 and above; and are at N\$10 to cater for treats given to the children after classes.
- 5. We appeal to parents to make donations for stationery for printing new booklets for Sunday school. Donations can be dropped at the Parish Office.
- 6. Parishioners who intend to get married are requested to **acquaint** themselves with the **Requirements List** posted on **Parish Notice Boards**; and are required to declare their intention at the Parish Office and register with the Parish Priest <u>Six (6)</u> **months** prior to their proposed marriage date.
- 7. The next **Pre-Marriage Workshop** is scheduled for **7**th **9**th **February 2025**, at **Maria Regina Oblate Conference Centre**, **Dobra.** Arrival and registration begin at **17h30**.
- 8. This year's **Walk with Christ** will be on **5**th **April 2025.** Support, in kind or financially, can be dropped at the Parish Office.
- The Spring Ball, which was to take place last September, will now take place on Saturday 1st March 2025. Details will be announced later. We thank you in advance for your support.
- 10. **Ushers** will hold a meeting on **Saturday 8**th **February 2025 at 15h00** in the classrooms below the Kindergarten. There is a great need for more ushers. Those willing to join are kindly invited to come to that meeting.
- 11. Apart from ushers, the PPC is also looking for people to make announcements after Mass on Saturdays & Sundays. The announcements will be prepared for you; and all you have to do is to read them out in a manner that will be explained to you.
