- 3. We appeal for donations for stationery for printing booklets for Sunday School. Donations can be dropped at the Parish Office.
- 4. From 07:30 to 11:00 on Wednesdays & Thursdays Fr Johannes will be giving classes at the Seminary and at the Pre-Novitiate, Dobra, respectively. Hence, he will not be in the Office.
- 5. The Parish is looking for additional people to serve in the following capacities:

  - iv. Announcer (to make announcements at the end of Mass on Saturdays & Sundays).

- 7. Parishioners who intend to get married are requested to **acquaint** themselves with the **Requirements List** posted on **Parish Notice Boards;** and are required to declare their intention at the Parish Office and register with the Parish Priest <u>Six (6) months</u> prior to their proposed marriage date.
- 8. This year's **Walk with Christ** will be on **5<sup>th</sup> April 2025.** Support, in kind or financially, can be dropped at the Parish Office.
- 9. The Spring Ball, which was to take place last September and was rescheduled to 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025, unfortunately has been rescheduled again to Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2025, due to Government order to cancel all gatherings of celebratory nature during the mourning period of the Father of the Nation, Sam Nujoma. However, the sale of tickets is continuing as it is only the date that changes. Further details will be announced later. We thank you in advance for your support.
